What is Import Of Records (IOR)



- ❑ IOR stands for "Importer of Record." The term refers to the entity or individual responsible for ensuring that imported goods comply with all applicable customs laws, regulations, and requirements.
- ❑ The Importer of Record is typically responsible for filing the necessary paperwork, paying import duties and taxes, and ensuring that the imported goods meet the necessary standards and regulations of the destination country.
- ❑ The Importer of Record can be the actual owner of the goods or an authorized representative acting on behalf of the owner.
